# *Elementary Camp 2025*

- **Campers** for Elementary Camp are those entering 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade in the Fall of 2025. Registration is limited to the first 100 campers and closes on Monday, July 7 – register online to reserve your space
- **Please bring:** Bible, notebook, pencil, warm sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight with extra batteries, several towels, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush/comb, sunscreen, modest swim suit (no bikinis or speedos), socks, underwear, several pair of comfortable shoes, warm clothes for cold nights and cool clothes for warm days (no short shorts – clothing deemed unacceptable by the staff will be changed or covered), sweatshirt and/or jacket. **You may also bring:** a foam bed pad or single air mattress
- **Please do not bring:** electronics, air soft guns, body spray, perfume, knives, pets, silly string, money, fireworks, iPad, video games, bad attitudes or anything illegal to avoid being sent home ☹
- **Registration** will be at Langlois Community Church on Monday afternoon (3:30-4:30pm). After registration campers will be instructed to head up the mountain to the camp where they will meet their counselor. Please note that there will be a lice check at registration.
- **Activities include:** swimming, archery, BB guns, slingshots, disc golf, basketball, volleyball, singing, games, night games, campfires, and the ever popular carpet pool!
- **All campers** (and their “**chauffeurs**” down the mountain) are required to check out with the dean at the dining hall before leaving on Friday morning! Campers must finish cleaning up their cabin and their area of camp *before* they may leave.
