The Goal: For campers to come to know Jesus for the first time, or for those that already do, to grow closer to Him.

Campers: Must be under 18 the week of camp, and going into 9th-12th grade. Registration is limited to the first 30 boy campers and 30 girl campers.

Counselors: Each counselors will lead a cabin throughout the week.

Please bring: Bible (no wifi means no digital bibles), note book, water bottle, mask, warm sleeping bag, pillow, towel, flashlight, toiletries (soap, tooth brush, etc.), coat, clothes for warm days and cold nights, swim suit (no bikinis, speedos), sunscreen, single air mattress or foam pad (highly recommended!)

Please DO NOT bring: air soft guns, pets, tobacco, alcohol, drugs,. All medication must be given to the camp nurse at registration.

Activities include: swimming, paint ball (fee applies), archery, .22 rifle range, disc golf, crafts, basketball, volleyball, night games, fireside, water day.

We will have a limit of 30 boy campers and 30 girl campers, so that we can have 2 cohorts of a maximum 30. Face masks are required, but not enforced. All people at camp will need to have temperature checked at registration. By nature of overnight camps, campers are likely to have close contact with other kids. We will do our best to keep kids safe. There will be no visitors allowed. Registration will be at Langlois Community Church from 1-3pm.
